

Human Trafficking Discussion Guide

The purpose of this discussion guide is to provide family planning staff an opportunity to review important facts about human trafficking and to review the policies and procedures that their clinic has in regard to human trafficking.

While an individual staff member can go through this discussion guide providing responses to each question, a richer discussion can occur when three or more staff view the webinar and discuss the guide questions as a group following the webinar.

1. How would you define sex trafficking and labor trafficking?
2. What are physical signs that may identify a victim of trafficking?
3. What are some behavioral signs that may identify a trafficking victim?
4. Describe a potential profile of a trafficking victim that could be seen in your clinic setting.
5. What are examples of possible assessment questions that may be useful in identifying a trafficking victim?
6. What are the resources in your community related to human trafficking?
7. What are your clinic's policies related to human trafficking?
8. If your site does not have a policy on trafficking, what are your policies on child sexual abuse and domestic violence? Can these policies be adapted? What steps need to be taken by who to develop a policy on trafficking?
9. If no policy exists, discuss a timeline, who is responsible and what resources are need to develop a policy.
10. How will a policy and procedures on trafficking be communicated to all staff to assure that the policy and procedures are followed.
